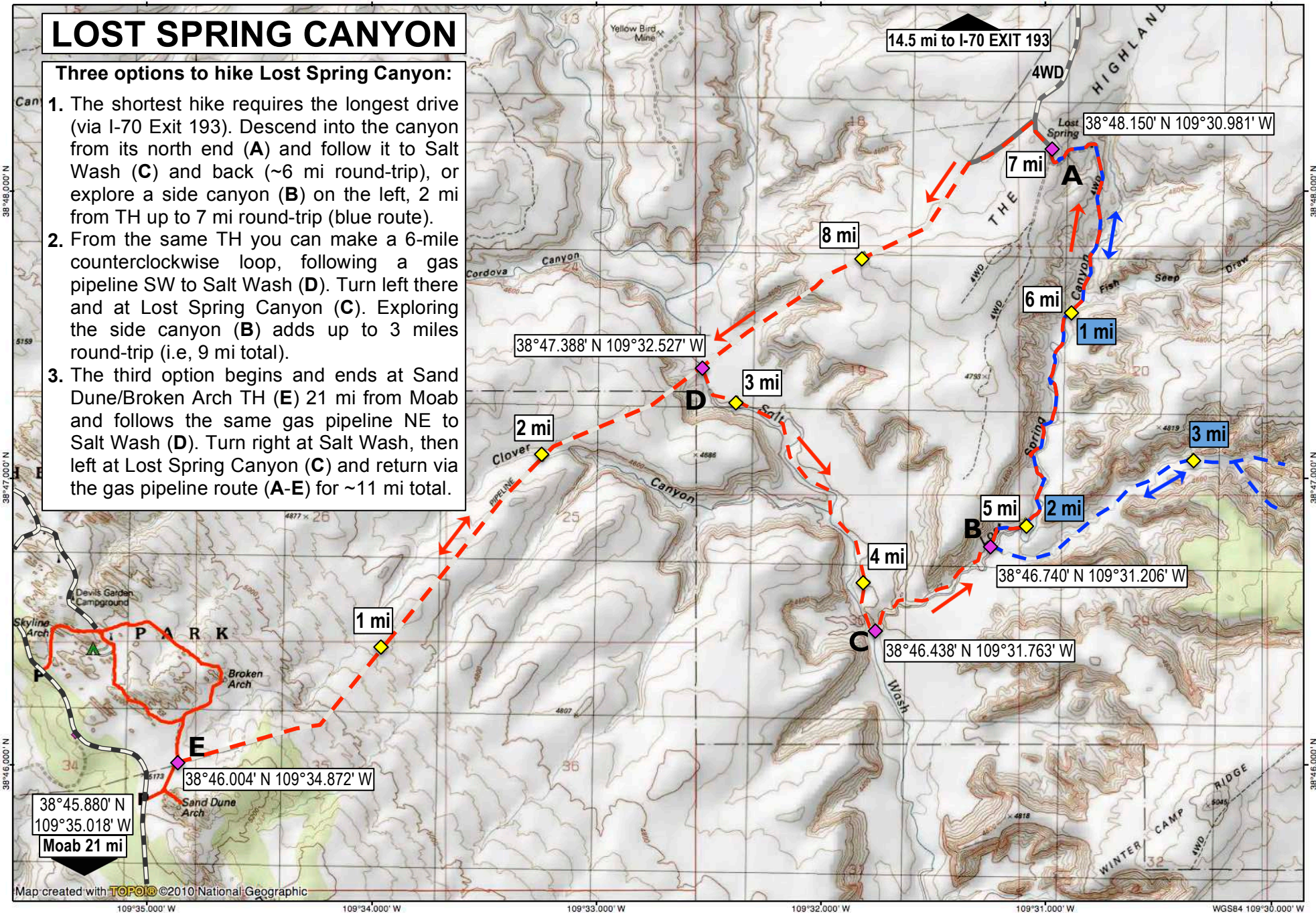

LOST SPRING CANYON

Three options to hike Lost Spring Canyon:

1. The shortest hike requires the longest drive (via I-70 Exit 193). Descend into the canyon from its north end (A) and follow it to Salt Wash (C) and back (~6 mi round-trip), or explore a side canyon (B) on the left, 2 mi from TH up to 7 mi round-trip (blue route).
2. From the same TH you can make a 6-mile counterclockwise loop, following a gas pipeline SW to Salt Wash (D). Turn left there and at Lost Spring Canyon (C). Exploring the side canyon (B) adds up to 3 miles round-trip (i.e., 9 mi total).
3. The third option begins and ends at Sand Dune/Broken Arch TH (E) 21 mi from Moab and follows the same gas pipeline NE to Salt Wash (D). Turn right at Salt Wash, then left at Lost Spring Canyon (C) and return via the gas pipeline route (A-E) for ~11 mi total.



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
