OCTOBER HIKES

Week of Oct 4 – **Raggeds Trail**, south of McClure Pass. Wooded trail climbs 2000' in 4 miles through mostly aspen (fall color).

Week of Oct 11 – **East Elk Creek**, west of New Castle, follows the creek, climbing 2800' in 5 miles. Tailgate at Jackie Nielson's.

Week of Oct 18 – **Colorow Trail Complex/Medaris Ridge**, at New Castle. A network of hiking & mountain biking trails in the hills north of New Castle offer a variety of terrain through mostly pinyon/ juniper woodland. Tailgate at Carol Boschert's.

Week of Oct 25 – **Ute Petroglyphs/Palisade**

Rim, east of Palisade, consists of a smaller 1.5-mile loop (petroglyphs) and a larger 4-mile loop (Rim), offering vistas of Mount Garfield and the Grand Valley. Tailgate by the river.
