OCTOBER DINNER

On **Thurs. Oct. 21st** we will enjoy delicious Mexican food at Frida's, 1814 Grand Ave. in GWS. Choose from 4 entrées and **order and pay for your own** dinner, drinks, desserts plus tax and gratuity. We ask that you tip the waitstaff at least 20% as Frida's management has really helped us out in a pinch. Entrée choices are as follows: **1)** Chicken Salad Grande @\$12.50, **2)** Chicken Enchiladas with rice & beans @\$16, **3)** Carne Asada with rice, beans and a tortilla @\$20, or **4)** Chile Relleno with a choice of rice & beans or a salad @\$16. This is a vegetarian and a gluten-free option. No exceptions to these choices will be made. Portions are very generous, but desserts are also available. You can see more detail on Frida's website: fridasglenwood.com. Arrive by 5:00 and be ready to order by 5:30. We want to allow Frida's to accommodate other customers, so it's important to order by 5:30 and not linger too long after eating if it gets busy. The maximum capacity for our group is 45 people so you will need to **RSVP to Bruce by Friday, Oct. 15**. We will have a wait list, so please also cancel by then if necessary. OCTOBER HIKES

See the **2021 Hiking Schedule/ Explanatory Notes** for secondary departure times/meeting places.

Oct 4 – Snowmass Rim/Skyline Ridge, 8:00 at Office Depot. At Snowmass Village, Snowmass Rim begins on Divide Road and ends at Town Park Center (9 mi/1000' w/shuttle). Skyline Ridge Loop begins/ends at Town Park Center (10 mi/1400'). Autumn classic.

Oct 11 – East Elk Creek/Spring Creek, 8:00 at Meadows Mall. At the end of East Elk Creek Road, just past the Nielson's house, follow East Elk (aka Centennial) Trail to its confluence with Spring Cr. (just past the East Elk Cr. crossing), where it exits a narrow gorge. Seasonally low flow should make the crossing manageable.

Oct 18 – Glassier/Buckhorn Loop, 8:30 at Office Depot. South of Willits, hike begins/ends at Hooks Lane TH and follows the Rio Grande Bike Trail to Glassier Trail, ascending to Buckhorn Traverse before descending Buckhorn Trail back to Rio Grande Trail (11.5 mi/700'). Fall color in the valley.

Oct 25 – Tour de New Castle, 9:00 at MM. Since we usurped Kathy's South Canyon hike, she's devising a fitting conclusion to our hiking season. Details to follow.
