Wednesdays at Sunlight: 10AM at the day lodge. Saturdays at Snowmass: 10AM at the Ullrhof (lower level) or 11:30-noon at High Alpine Cafeteria (upper level). Remember, masks are required indoors at all Skico facilities, as well as gondolas and gondola lines. Proof of vaccination also is required at Cloud Nine Restaurant (including the outdoor deck) at Highlands, and at the Alpin Room, Lynn Britt Cabin and Sam's Smokehouse Restaurant at Snowmass.

You can carpool to Snowmass or take one of RFTA's "ASPEN BRT" buses (free for 65+) departing every 15 min with few stops (Carbondale, El Jebel, Willits and Basalt). Transfer to a Snowmass shuttle at Brush Creek (aka Intercept Lot) or take the Snowmass Express bus direct to Snowmass Mall leaving Glenwood's 27th Street Station daily at 7:23 am.
