AUGUST HIKES

Dates in bold typeface are Wednesdays (more strenuous). See the **2022 Hiking Schedule** and **Explanatory Notes** for secondary departure times/meeting places.

August 1 – Lost Man, 7:00 at RF. Near Independence Pass, this hike is a 100 Club classic. Options abound: 1) a 9.5-mile crossover in either direction, 2) lower TH to Lost Man Lake/Pass and return (12.5-14 miles RT, 2300') or 3) upper TH to Pass/Lake and return (4-5 miles RT, 1300').

August 8 – Forest Hollow/Hubbard Cave, 8:00 at RF. This is the eastern approach to the Forest Hollow Trail, as well as the Hubbard's Cave Trail, following a 4WD road from the Lookout Mountain Road.

Unfortunately, the cave is closed to prevent spread of highly contagious white-nose disease in bats.

August 10 – East Snowmass Creek/Willoughby Mtn., 6:00 at RF. At Snowmass Village (Divide Road), take the Ditch Trail 2 mi to the East Snowmass Creek Trail. Follow the trail to the pass (up to 7 mi, 3800') or depart trail at 3.5 mi and bushwhack to Willoughby summit (5.5 mi, 4200').

August 15 – Fancy Pass/Missouri Lakes Loop, 7:00 at NN. From US 24 south of Minturn near Tennessee Pass, turn right on Homestake Road to the Missouri Lakes TH. From the same TH hike either the steeper Fancy Pass Trail past Treasure Vault Lake to Missouri Lakes and return via Missouri Lakes Trail (9-mi, 2600') or hike to lakes and back on Missouri Lakes Trail (8 mi, 2000').

August 22 – Nolan Lake, 8:00 at NN. South of Eagle, near Fulford, a short trail climbs 1600' in 3 miles to an alpine lake.

August 24 – Constantine/Tuhare Lakes, 6:30 at NN. S of Minturn at the Halfmoon CG (end of Tigiwon Road). Follow the Fall Creek Trail to Lake Constantine (4 mi, 800') or take a spur trail above Constantine to upper Tuhare Lake (6 mi, 2000') OR **Notch Mountain**, same time, same place. Spur trail below Constantine leads to a view of the cross couloir on Mount of the Holy Cross (5 mi, 2700').

August 29 – Sawyer Lake, near Norrie Colony east of Ruedi Res. Wooded trail ascends 1500' in 5 miles to a beautiful lake. Bonus: circumnavigate the lake for additional mileage.

BICYCLING

August 3 – Capital Creek. Meet at 9:00 am at Grace Church off Hwy 82 by the old Emma schoolhouse. Ride East Sopris Creek Road (mostly paved except 3-1/2 miles of hard dirt doable on a road bike) to Capital Creek Road. Turn right and ride to the end of the pavement. Then turn around, descend to Snowmass Creek Road and ride to the Aspen Deaf Camp. Descend back over East Sopris Creek for a total of 30 miles. Lunch at Casa Tequila off of 82 in El Jebel.

August 17 – Road to Lenado (Ride description & route TBD).

August 31 – Annual "Tour De Missouri Heights". Meet at 9:30 at Sylvia Wendrow's Missouri Heights home, at 85 Prince Drive. Maps of approx. 15-mile tour route will be available at Sylvia's & also can be emailed to everyone interested. A portion of the route is on hard-packed dirt road doable by road bikes. If you want more of a challenge, bike up from El Jebel or Catherine Store to Prince Dr.-- or make a side trip through Panorama or White Cloud subdivision along the basic route. No potluck this year but bring your own food & drink for lunch on Sylvia's patio after the ride. She will provide some appetizers, some dessert, ice water and lemonade.
