And drop boxes for paper ballots are available 24/7 outside Carbondale Town Hall, the Courthouse in Glenwood, New Castle Town Hall, Silt Town Hall and Rifle County Admin Building. By the time you receive this Newsletter, it may be too late to mail your ballots, so drop boxes offer a convenient...and free...option. But remember, no ballots will be accepted after 7pm on Election Day, Nov 8.
