JULY HIKES

Aug 7-11 – **Silverton Trip**, 7:00 at Rifle Rest Area. We'll spend 5 fun-filled days exploring the San Juans. Details will be posted in the **Hikers' Blog**.

Aug 14 – **Savage Lakes**, 7:00 at REI. After a hiatus of several years due to fallen timber on the trail, we are pleased to reinstate this perennial favorite east of Ruedi reservoir. We will rendezvous with up-valley hikers at Two Rivers Road in Basalt at 7:30.

Aug 21 – **New York Mountain**, 7:00 at NN or **Nolan Lake**, 8:00 at NN. South of Eagle near Fulford, the New York Range is prominent on the horizon. Brad Jennings will lead us on a tour of New York Mountain from their cabin on its NW flanks. If you'd rather sleep in and take a less arduous hike, the Nolan Lake trail starts near Fulford and climbs 1600' in 3 miles to a beautiful cirque lake.

Aug 23 – **East Snowmass Creek-Maroon Lake Crossover or Willow Pass/Lake**, 6:00 at REI or 6:45 at Brush Creek P&R. Trail-heads are the Ditch Trail on Divide Road in Snowmass Village and Maroon Lake, respectively. Willow Pass drivers have reservations to park at Maroon Lake. Crossover hikers from East Snowmass Creek will arrange transportation back to Snowmass Village or Brush Creek P&R with Willow Pass drivers.

Aug 28 – **Avalanche Creek or Hell Roaring Creek**, 7:00 at REI. South of Carbondale, both hikes originate at the same trailhead. Avalanche Creek hikers must cross Hell Roaring Creek (passable with caution) about 2.5 mi from the TH.

BICYCLING

Aug 2 – **Capital Creek and Old Snowmass Road**. Meet at 9:00am for a 9:15 start at the Old Snowmass Park & Ride. We will take a group photo at the start. Ride from there up Capital Creek Road to the end of the pavement & return. Then continue over to Snowmass Creek Road, ride up also to the end of the pavement & return (22 Total miles, 1/2 of it is a beautiful downhill!). Optional lunch at Casa Tequila off Hwy 82 in El Jebel.

Easy Riders: Glenwood Canyon. Meet at Two Rivers Park at 9:00am. Ride the bike path along the Colorado River to Shoshone and back (trail is closed beyond that until Bair Ranch). Lunch at Slope and Hatch.

Aug 16 – Annual "**Tour De Missouri Heights**." Meet at 9:30 at Sylvia Wendrow's Missouri Heights home at 85 Prince Drive. Group photo! Ride begins 9:45. Maps of approx. 15-mile tour route will be available at Sylvia's & also can be emailed to anyone interested. A portion of the route is on hard-packed dirt road doable by road bikes. If you want more of a challenge, bike up from El Jebel, join me in biking from Catherine Store to Prince Drive or make a side trip through Panorama or White Cloud subdivision along the basic route. No potluck, but bring your own food & drink for lunch on Sylvia's patio after the ride.

Easy Riders: Same as above. We will join the "Tour De Missouri Heights" today!

Aug 30 – **Frying Pan Road: Ruedi Dam to end of pavement**. Meet at 9:00 am for a 9:15 start at milepost 14 on Frying Pan Rd. Group photo! You will find a large parking area just above the dam.

This is a moderately challenging 36-mile out-and-back ride on a sinuous, undulating paved road along Ruedi Reservoir and through the towns of Meredith and Thomasville, with breathtaking vistas and the reservoir, of course. Take plenty of water; this is a challenging ride. Optional lunch at Topsy Trout in Basalt.

Easy Riders: New Castle to Silt and back (~14 miles). Meet at 9:00am at City Market parking lot near Alpine bank. We will ride across the river and up county road 335 to Silt and back to New Castle on Peach Valley Road. Lunch at Tapatios.
