Glenwood Springs Community Concert Association's fall season is set to begin on September 23rd with a performance by the Folk Legacy Trio. Two long-time members of the Kingston Trio and the lead singer from the Diamonds will be entertaining us with songs from the great folk era. Four more concerts will fill out our musical season, including a gifted young classical pianist who also plays jazz and innovates on stage, 3 Divas singing 40 years of pops greats, an award-winning Australian guitar and vocal duo, and a talented trio singing Broadway favorites and classics accompanied by piano and cello. SEPTEMBER HIKES

Sep 4 – **Woody Creek**, 7:00 at REI. Ever wonder why they call it Woody Creek. This hike will answer that question as the trail climbs 2800' in 5.5 miles through mixed greens...dressing on the side.

Sep 6 – **Charles/Mystic Island Lakes OR Ironedge/Lake Charles Loop**, 7:00 at No Name. These 2 hikes share the same TH at the end of East Brush Creek Rd. S of Eagle. The first follows East Brush Creek, climbing 1700' in 4.5 miles to Lake Charles. Continue 1 mile with 200' additional gain to Mystic Island Lake. The latter hike diverges from East Brush Creek at the trailhead, climbing Ironedge Ridge 2600' in 4 miles before descending back to East Brush Creek at Lake Charles.

Sep 11 – **North Fork/Lone Pine Loop**, 8:00 at REI. Behind Basalt Mountain, there are multiple loop options or hike out-and-back. The shorter loop is 6.2 miles with 800' gain, and the longer loop is 9.6 miles with 1400' gain...some steep. Whichever you choose, but sure to visit the Lone Pine for which the trail gets its name.

Sep 18-22 – **Salida Trip**, 7:00 at No Name. Look for details in the **Hikers' Blog** early in September.

Sep 25 – **Huntsman Ridge**, 8:00 at REI. Off McClure Pass, this popular route climbs steeply 2100' in 4 miles with spectacular views into Coal Basin (north) and West Elk Mountains (south). Fall color!

BICYCLING

Sep 13 – **Road to Lenado**. Meet on the Rio Grande bike path at Old Snowmass. Details will be sent a few days before the ride. Brad Jennings will be your leader on this one. Bike from Old Snowmass to Lenado and back. Beautiful ride! A bit of gravel at the end. Meet at 9:15. Ride begins at 9:30. **Easy Riders:** Join us at the trailhead & bike the Rio Grande Trail as far as you want & turn around.

Sep 27 – **Maroon Bells**. Meet at the Tiehack parking lot. It's a beautiful ride across the foot/bike bridge on Government Trail to Maroon Creek Road. Ride up to the Bells & return. Total: 20 miles RT. Meet at 9:15. Ride begins at 9:30. **Easy Riders:** Join us!
