ALPINE SKIING

Join us Saturdays for a delightful day of skiing at **Snowmass**. Meet at Ullrhof (on the bench by the restrooms) at 10am or High Alpine Restaurant (upper level) at noon. Drive/carpool or take RFTA. The bus is free to seniors 65+, and a Snowmass express departs 27th Station daily at 7:23. A PM down-valley express departs Snowmass every half hour beginning at 3:15.

Sunlight is open for the 2024-25 season, with all 3 lifts running. We meet every Wednesday at 10am in the day lodge. Powder hounds may opt to take the 8:30 Tercero "express" to pound the early pow (powder pass required). But stop by the day lodge at 10am if you'd like company. Your quads will need a rest by then anyway.
