<u>Cinco de Mayo</u> – **Colorow Trail Complex**, 8:30 at Meadows Mall or 8:45 at Alder Park. Route to be selected by the leader. Tailgate at Carol Boschert's.

May 12-16 – **Moab Trip**, 7:00 at Rifle Rest Area. Further info will be posted on our website one week before our 5-day (4-night) spring excursion.

May 19 – Boy Scout Trail/Cemetery Loop, 9:00 at trailhead. This 6-mile loop begins by climbing the Boy Scout Trail from 8th Street to Forest Hollow. Follow the Forest Hollow Trail south, descend to the Pioneer Cemetery and return to 8th Street via Palmer Ave. Tailgate on the Burg's patio at 1604 Bennett.

May 26 – Storm King Fire-fighters Memorial Trail/Loop, 9:00 at Meadows Mall, 9:10 at TH. The trail begins east of Canyon Creek exit from I-70 and climbs steeply to a series of sites where firefighters lost their lives during the 1994 South Canyon fire. Drop vehicle(s) at South Canyon exit to take the escape route loop. Tailgate at the Herbst's Canyon Creek "estate".

May 28 – Arbaney-Kittle, 8:00 at REI, 9:00 at Holland Hills TH. The trail climbs steeply for 2 miles to expansive views of the Elk Mountain Range. Early wildflowers typically abound.
