JUNE HIKES

June 2 – **RAMBO**, 8:00 at Meadows Mall or 8:30 at Rifle City Market. Not another Sly Stallone Vietnam War movie, but the <u>Rifle Area Mountain Bike Organization trail complex north of Rifle. Route to be selected by the leader.</u>

June 9 – Nancy's Path, 9:00 at REI, 9:30 at Hooks Lane. South of Willitts, this trail climbs 1500' in 3 miles to a beautiful view of Mount Sopris. Difficult route-finding.

June 11 – Triangle Peak, 8:00 at REI, 8:35 at Old Snowmass P&R. This steep climb (2400' in 4 miles) follows a 4WD road from Upper River Road west of Woody Creek. The road is closed to motor vehicles until June 21, so you won't have the company of 4-wheelers.

The payoff is an amazing panoramic view from a rocky outcrop.

June 16 – Lorax, 9:00 at REI, 9:15 at Carbondale (Main Street west of roundabout), or 9:30 at TH. The trail begins off Thompson Creek Road just past its junction with Dry Park Road. The undulating trail meanders through a land-scape of mostly pinyon pine and juniper. Popular with both hikers and mountain bikers.

June 23 – Three Forks, 7:30 at Meadows Mall, additional meeting place TBA. North of Rifle Mountain Park, this popular trail (with 100 Club members) climbs 1700' in 5.5 miles to a meadow at Bar HL Park. Look for "artwork" on aspens.

June 25 – **Rocky Fork**, 7:30 at REI or 7:55 at Two Rivers Road. At the foot of Ruedi Dam, this 6-mile trail climbs 1900' before fading into obscurity in a wet meadow.

June 30 – Hay Park Crossover, 8:00 at REI, up-valley meeting place(s) TBA. Between Emma and Carbondale, this 10-mile hike can be done as a through hike with key exchange beginning at either Dinkle Lake or Capitol Creek. Alternatively, you can hike up to 5 miles out and back from Dinkle Lake. Hiking from Capitol Creek out and back isn't recommended, due to two potentially wet stream crossings (four round-trip) on that side.

JUNE BIKE RIDES

<u>June 4</u> – **Harvey Gap Loop**. The first official ride of the season will

begin in New Castle starting at 9:00 am at City Market parking lot. The loop is approximately 22 miles with undulating hills. We'll turn off the main county road and head up toward Buford to add a few miles for a slight detour that connects back to the main county road right before the turn to Harvey Gap.

Fast riders' speed is generally 12-15 mph. Easy riders may turn around at Harvey Gap and come back the same way (Kathy is gone so no official easy rider leader). Make a day of it and bring a lunch and paddleboard and head back to Harvey Gap for paddle boarding/kayaking after the ride.

June 18 – Colorado River Road. A beautiful road north of Dotsero along the Colorado River for 16 miles (end of pavement) with rolling hills (some a bit steep). Total mileage is 32 miles. Meet at 9:00 am (BOB – butts on bike!) at the Ute trailhead parking lot. Exit I-70 at Dotsero, turn left and drive under I-70 to the roundabout and continue north on Colorado River Road. The parking area is located a few hundred yards north of the roundabout and on the left side (west) of the road.

Easy Riders meet Kathy Kline at 9:00 am at No Name rest area for a beautiful ride on the Glenwood Canyon bike path.
